Right to Negotiate

When negotiations are successfully concluded, staff will present the contract to Rancho Santa Fe Board of Directors for approval.

Single Proposal.

In the event a single proposal is received, the District will, at its option, conduct a price and/or cost analysis of the proposal and either accept, negotiate the award, or reject the proposal and re-advertise. A price analysis would be performed by comparing price quotations submitted on other current quotations, current price lists, or other established or competitive prices

Terms of Payment:

A Fire District Purchase Order at time of contract award. Payment made in full upon delivery and acceptance of vehicle. Price is FOB Rancho Santa Fe, California. Sales tax to be shown as separate item.
