### **WILDLAND FIRE BURNS ONE ACRE NEAR LAKE HODGES**

**SAN DIEGO, CALIF.** – Today at 2:53 p.m., firefighters responded to a wildland fire near Lake Hodges of Lake Drive and Cedar Lane. The fire, which had a large potential to be devastating due to the terrain, was limited to one acre and was put out in about 30 minutes. No structures were threatened and no injuries were reported.

Firefighters from Rancho Santa Fe, San Diego, Escondido, and the California Department of Forestry responded to the scene. They were aided in their efforts with air support from Copter 1, Copter 10, and Copter 12. The cause of the fire is currently under investigation.

The mission of the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District is “To protect life, property, and environment through prevention, preparedness, education and emergency response.” Formed in 1946, the Fire District now spans approximately 42-square miles and protects over 21,500 citizens. The Fire District currently operates out of four full-time fire stations and serves the communities within and surrounding Rancho Santa Fe and 4S-Ranch.
