NEWS RELEASE – RESCUE INCIDENT

On August 20, 2007, at 8:05 a.m., Rancho Santa Fe firefighters and paramedics responded to a traffic collision on El Camino Del Norte near Paseo Delicias. Upon arrival on scene they found two cars on opposite sides of the road with major damage. The drivers of both vehicles were treated for injuries and transported to a local hospital. El Camino Del Norte was temporarily closed between Paseo Delicias and Lago Lindo while emergency crews assisted those involved
