**FIREFIGHTERS PARTNER WITH TONY HAWK, COMPANIES TO HELP YOUNG  
FIRE VICTIMS**

**RANCHO SANTA FE, Calif.** — The Rancho Santa Fe Professional Firefighters Association has partnered with professional skateboarder Tony Hawk and companies to help kids whose homes were lost to the fire. They have secured donations of bikes, skateboards, clothes, and backpacks all of which will be distributed to young fire victims. Over 150 children have been invited to a special event on Saturday, December 8, 2007 at 9:00 a.m. at the Village Community Presbyterian Church, 6225 Paseo Delicias, in Rancho Santa Fe, receive their gifts.

Since the Witch Creek Fire burned into the District in October, Firefighter/Paramedic Chris Danner has been working with Hawk and organizations such as The Tony Hawk Foundation, Dynacraft, Birdhouse, Bravo, Rock-It Cargo, 900 Films, and Tech Deck to secure the donated items. Rancho Santa Fe Firefighters and members of the Village Community Presbyterian Church volunteered their time to assemble the bikes and will be at the private event to present the items to the children.

The mission of the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District is "To protect life, property, and environment through prevention, preparedness, education and emergency response." Formed in 1946, the Fire District now spans approximately 42-square miles and protects over 21,000 citizens. The Fire District currently operates out of four full-time fire stations and serves the communities within and surrounding Rancho Santa Fe and 4S-Ranch.
