### **INJURED BICYCLIST FLOWN TO HOSPITAL**

**RANCHO SANTA FE, Calif.** — At 11:26 a.m., firefighters from the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District responded to a report of a bicycle accident on El Camino del Norte at Las Montanas. Based on the information provided to dispatch by an off-duty San Diego Fire Captain who was on scene, it was determined that Mercy Air should be called to transport the victim. Upon arrival on scene, firefighters found a male in his 60's on the ground and in an altered state of consciousness. Paramedics treated him until he was transported by Mercy Air to Scripps Memorial Hospital in La Jolla in critical condition.

The mission of the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District is “To protect life, property, and environment through prevention, preparedness, education and emergency response.” Formed in 1946, the Fire District now spans approximately 42-square miles and protects over 29,000 citizens. The Fire District currently operates out of four full-time fire stations and serves the communities within and surrounding Rancho Santa Fe and 4S-Ranch.
