CHILD FLOWN TO HOSPITAL FOLLOWING TRAFFIC COLLISION

RANCHO SANTA FE, Calif. — On Thursday, August 20th at 3:15 pm, emergency personnel from the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District responded to a traffic collision involving three vehicles on El Camino Real next to San Dieguito Park. A total of six patients were assessed, with one patient requiring transportation to Children’s Hospital via an air ambulance. Two patients were transported by ground ambulance to Scripps Memorial Hospital in La Jolla and one patient was transported to Scripps Hospital in Encinitas. The two remaining patients refused treatment and were released on scene.

The mission of the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District is “To protect life, property, and environment through prevention, preparedness, education and emergency response.” Formed in 1946, the Fire District now spans approximately 42-square miles and protects over 29,000 citizens. The Fire District currently operates out of four full-time fire stations and serves the communities within and surrounding Rancho Santa Fe and 4S-Ranch.
