### **INJURED HORSEMAN FLOWN TO HOSPITAL**

**4S RANCH, Calif.** — On Tuesday, October 6, 2009, at 3:40 p.m., Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District firefighters responded to the report of a man injured by a horse. Upon arrival at the scene on Camino Santa Fe, they found a 74-year-old man unconscious. It appeared as though he had sustained head injury when the horse he had been working with kicked him and ran him over. Paramedics were able to secure an airway and called for Mercy Air to transport him to a local trauma center for treatment.
