a. Fire Chief - Pavone

He reported on the following topics:

- Fairbanks Ranch Replacement Fire Station Update
 - Captain Chris Galindo has been assigned to the Administrative Captain position and has "jumped in" on this project to keep the process moving forward.
 - Building Permit the last issue (traffic signal) has been resolved with the County. A plan was
 developed that met the needs of both the County and Fire District. The comments from the
 County are due this week on the first submittal of plans. He anticipates a letter of conditional
 approval in early January.
 - Station Demolition the notice inviting bids for station demolition will be advertised by December 15. The bid period will be open for 30 days. Once the successful bidder is selected, he anticipates the demolition work to begin within two weeks. The District is seeking bids to remove the trees so that the grading work will not be delayed.
 - o Interim Fire Station anticipate a move in date of December 15
 - New Construction no additional information.
- Management Services Contract The leadership task force continues to meet, and issues that have been identified are being resolved. All agencies continue to be positive in this effort.
