## TWO INJURED IN SINGLE VEHICLE ACCIDENT

**RANCHO SANTA FE, Calif.** — On Friday, August 26, at 8:41 pm, firefighters from the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District and Escondido Fire Department responded to the report of a traffic collision in the 9000 block of Del Dios Highway. Upon arrival, crews found a single vehicle, which had been traveling westbound, had gone off the road and landed on its side. Two occupants were trapped. Crews quickly worked to extricate the patients, who were transported via ambulance to Palomar Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries. California Highway Patrol is investigating the cause of the accident.

The mission of the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District is “To serve the public through the protection of life, environment and property from fire and other emergencies through prevention, preparedness, education, and response.” Formed in 1946, the Fire District now spans approximately 50-square miles and protects over 32,000 citizens.
