President Ashcraft called to order the regular session of the Rancho Santa Fe Fire Protection District Board of Directors at 9:30 am.

4. Oral Report

- a. <u>Fire Chief Michel</u>
 - Fairbanks Ranch Replacement Fire Station Update: Captain Galindo distributed an update on project. He reported that there were no weather delays this past month, the first floor drywall is complete, and the second floor is in progress. The curb and gutters are complete. He continues to request from the contractor for a date of completion, as there are items such as furniture that must be ordered.
 - ii) Sharing of Resources with City of Encinitas: to date he has not received the necessary maps to analyze. A new date has yet to be determined for a governance meeting. The leadership team is pursuing the different options of sharing resource. They have completed the discussions with the various labor groups to discuss any concerns.
 - iii) District Activities
 - Spaghetti Dinner June 18, 2011: the event went very well and they estimated 600 700 people were in attendance. He commended Engineer Brian Slattery for a job well done in the coordination of the event.
 - (2) Local Responsibility Area (LRA): CalFire has distributed a new State Responsibility Area (SRA) map. The 4S Ranch area and parts of Santa Fe Valley were transferred from SRA to LRA. It will be important to train district personnel to ensure that the District is able to obtain cost recovery should a major incident occur.
- b. Operations Chief Ward
 - i) He and Chief Gibbs are in the process of updating response plans. He also reported that the weather is predicted to be warmer and hotter through the months of February. CDF is fully staffed; however, staffing levels have been reduced to three persons on an engine.

EMS Coordinator Murphy informed the Board that there have been five CPR saves, and two were within the fire district. The survival rate is above the national average. She anticipates using the data towards educating the public later this year.

5. Closed Session – Time Certain 10:00 am

Pursuant to section 54957 54956.8 the Board met in closed session from 10:02 to 10:10 to discuss the following:

Upon reconvening, President Ashcraft reported only agenda item 5. a. was discussed and there was no action taken. Also, the board agreed by consensus to reconvene to closed session at the conclusion of all open session matters for discussion and or action.

4. Oral Report (cont.)

- c. <u>Training Battalion Chief Davidson</u>
 - i) Chief Davidson summarized the following training activity for all personnel:
 - (1) Wildland drill approximately 1,000 firefighters participated in the three day drill
 - (2) Forcible entry training

- (3) Social media training, this included a focus on the public employee rights vs. private employee rights. He agreed to provide the board members a copy of the material distributed from the social media training.
- d. Fire Prevention Fire Marshal Hunter
 - i) He summarized the staff report for future development in the fire district and responded to questions from the board.
 - ii) He updated the board on the weed abatement activity. The intern has been working with the shelter-in-place communities, and has had good compliance. He distributed a report showing the collections of mitigation fees for the County.
- e. <u>Administrative Manager Rannals</u>
 - i) FY12 Assessed Valuation: she reported that the District's assessed valuation was received on July 18th, which decreased an additional 1.7% from the FY11 year.
 - ii) CalPERS: The investment rate of return for FY11 is 20.65%
 - CalPERS Conference October 24 26, 2011: she extended an invitation to the board members for the upcoming conference. Board members agreed to review their calendars and respond at the next meeting.
- f. Board of Directors
 - i) North County Dispatch JPA Update: the next meeting is scheduled for August 25, 2011.
 - ii) County Service Area 17 Update: the next meeting is scheduled for August 2, 2011. Director Hickerson is unable to attend. Director Tanner will attend as the alternate.
 - iii) Comments
 - (1) Malin: discussed a news article about employees in Chula Vista and Oceanside paying part of the employer costs to the pension system.
 - (2) Ashcraft: continues to watch the redistricting process for State Assembly. He thanked Chief Michel for attending the hearing on Monday, June 20. He hopes that the fire district will have only one assembly and senate seat in the legislature.

Chief Michel reviewed the requirements of government code section 913 and responded to questions from the board. It was recommended that the board reject the claim.

The district is paying for the actual specialty inspections and reports requested by the County of San Diego. He responded to questions from the Board.







20	accident, injury thereof, etc. Claimants, by their attorneys, are investigating the accident.	
21	Nevertheless, it is claimed to date that Ms. Clow may, upon information and belief, have (based	
22	only upon allegations and/or insinuations by the driver of the vehicle that hit Ms. Clow and/or	
23	the defense counsel for the driver that hit Ms. Clow in the course of discovery) either sustained	
24	injuries or had said injuries she sustained worsened, in part, due to action/inaction on the part of	
25	Respondents and each of them by and through their agents, servants, employees, and/or joint	
26	venturers, and each of them potentially mismanaging the fire scene, not closing down the road,	
27	misdirecting traffic, and/or not giving timely or proper EMT care at the scene via their medical	
28	personnel to the victim Ms. Clow.	

The Clows and their counsel file this governmental claim in an abundance of caution due
 to the impending possible expiration of a claim filing time period and reserve all rights to take future
 positions on the matter including but not limited to that the governmental entities may bear little or
 no responsibility whatsoever, as it is very early in the investigation of the matter and defense counsel
 for the driver has yet to answer discovery served upon his office.

Claimants provisionally allege that at all times relevant to this action, the Respondents and 6 each of them set forth in the caption of this claim as well as those on the proof of service were, and 7 still are, governmental entities that jointly and severally owned, managed, maintained, and inspected 8 where the incident took place (hereinafter "accident scene") as alleged herein, employed persons at 9 10 the scene, and/or rendered aid most likely at the scene or close by. Claimants provisionally allege, to the extent may be shown by proof, that according to others, said Respondents and their agents, 11 servants, employees and contractors, actions may have caused or exacerbated Claimants' damages 12 based upon the allegations of the driver of the van and/or his attorney. Claimants provisionally 13 allege, to the extent may be shown by proof, that according to others, the aforementioned accident 14 scene may have been in a dangerous condition that created a substantial risk of serious personal 15 injury or death, which damages were in fact sustained by Claimants, when the street was used in a 16 manner that was reasonably foreseeable, casting Respondents in liability. Claimants provisionally 17 allege, to the extent may be shown by proof, that according to others, that the Respondents, through 18 their agents, servants, employees and/or contractors, violated various statutes, laws, regulations and 19 ordinances and otherwise failed to discharge mandatory duties pertaining to the supervision, 20 maintenance, and inspection of the accident scene, casting the Respondents in liability. 21

As a result of the potentially dangerous conditions on the street, and possibility of instruction or at the direction of Respondents' agents at the scene of the fire on Avenida Suavidad, a motorist of a van reversed from the street and ran over the left foot of Shemiran Clow, a pedestrian, who sustained multiple fractures to her foot, along with an open foot wound requiring a skin graft which may have not been properly and timely treated by, inter alia, EMT personnel.

Claimants are further informed and believe and thereon allege that any arguable immunities
do not apply factually or legally, or, alternatively, that if any do apply that they have been lost by the

applicable governmental entities.

Claimants have been damaged in sums which exceed the jurisdictional limits of all lower courts which would otherwise have jurisdiction, which amounts will be shown according to proof at time of trial.

A general description of the indebtedness, obligation, injury, damage or loss injury incurred so far as it is known at the time the claim is presented:

The Claims include, but are not limited to, the following: fractured left metatarsal and lateral malleoulus, left foot open wound requiring skin graft, exposed tendons and soft tissue, left foot skin avulsion, possible RSD, and other various serious injuries by Shemiran Clow and loss of consortium by her husband Geoffrey Clow.

Claimants claim all damages resulting from potential and alleged possible wrong doing on the part of Respondents which may be found to have caused or aggravated the injuries to Claimants as well as the damages associated therewith. The facts known to Claimants supporting the above causes of action are set forth herein in item 3 and the documents attached. However, discovery continues. Damages claimed are compensatory, and include both economic and non-economic damages for pain suffering, LOE and medical treatment charges.

7 5. The name or names of the public employees allegedly causing the injury, if known:

8 The identities of all persons involved on behalf of the Respondents is not known at this time.
9 However, according to the police report, numerous police, and fire department personnel are

(extensive medical fees accumulated and lost wages) and general damages, (loss of consortium, attorneys fees and costs to the extent allowed by law), the breakdown of which Claimants will leave to the trier of fact, as well as punitive damages claimed to the extent permitted against a public employee. No part of the action will be a limited civil case. The case would be filed in San Diego County Superior Court, Unlimited Civil Division, and will seek, at least, the above referenced damages.



3 Cordova (-P-1) told me she noticed the street was blocked by fire trucks, because of a large 4 house fire. He decided to back his van away from the fire trucks to go another direction. While he 5 was driving the van in reverse, Cordova heard a loud thump and thought his flood equipment fell 6 inside the van and kept moving. However, when he heard someone yell out to him to stop the

7 van, that is when he discovered a pedestrian was struck by the van.

When she 19 was struck by the van, she fell to the ground. A pedestrian that saw the collision walked a 20 21 crossed the street to render aid to Shemiran Ablakatof-Clow.



A single-family home on the 16300 block of Avenida Suavidad caught fire Monday afternoon causing extensive da mage, but the two people and one dog inside made it out safely. Two firefighters suffer ed minor burns to their ears and neck.

The fire started in a first -floor office around 12:30 p.m. and firefighters were able to control it within 10-15 minutes and put it out soon thereafter, Fire Capt. Chris Bablar said. The fire spread to the garage, destroying its contents, and caused an u pstairs window to burst. Officials initially estimated the dam age at \$150,000-\$200,000, but later raised the figure to \$600,000: \$400,000 for the structure and \$200,000 for the contents.

Investigators determined the fire was caused by a faulty HP printer, San Diego Fire-Rescue Department spo kesman Maurice Lugue said in an e-mail Tuesday.

The homeowners and their d og sat across the street fr om their home as firefighters surveyed the damage. Several people from the neighborhood came by to give their well wishes to the couple, who said they will be "well taken care of" in the aftermath of the fire.

One ambulance, four engines and three ladder trucks responded to the fire.

The street was temporarily blocked off, but by 3 p.m. police officers were allowing some vehicles to pass through.

RB house fire leads to pedestrian injury

By Elizabeth Marie Himchak

A malfunctioning computer printer sparked a fire that caused an estimated \$600,000 in damage to a Rancho Bernardo home on Monday, said a fire official.

In addition, a neighbor was hit by a vehicle while watching firefighters extinguish the blaze.

The fire was reported at 12:35 p.m. Jan. 17 at 16306 Avenida Suavidad, according to San Diego Fire-Rescue Spokesman Maurice Luque.

"There was a lot of smoke and fire when crews arrived," Luque said, adding the fire was extinguished within 20 minutes. Crews from Rancho Bernardo, Carmel Mountain Ranch, Rancho Penasquitos, Mira Mesa, Poway, and Miramar responded.

Fire officials estimated damage at \$400,000 to the two-story home and \$200,000 in lost contents, he said.

The cause was identified as a malfunctioning Hewlett-Packard printer in a downstairs room that served as an office, Luque said.

While two firefighters sustained mild burns to their ears, which Luque compared in severity to a "sunburn," he added the commotion led to a pedestrian near the scene getting hit by a vehicle.

San Diego Police Lt. Andra Brown said a van parked on the street was being slowly backed up to make room for fire vehicles when it knocked over and then rolled over a 55-year-old woman who lives nearby and came outside to see what was going on.

The driver immediately stopped after hearing witnesses yelling about the accident at 12:48 p.m., Brown said, adding the driver will not be cited.

The woman was taken to Palomar Medical Center for a broken left ankle and sore left shoulder and hip, Brown said.

\$600,000 Fire to Rancho Bernardo House Blamed on Computer Printer

SAN DIEGO - A fire that tore through a house in Rancho Bernardo on Martin Luther King Jr. Day caused an estimated \$600,000 worth of damage, a fire department spokesman said Wednesday.

Flames began spreading through the residence in the 13600 block of Avenida Suavidad about 12:30 p.m. Monday. Two adults were home at the time but were able to escape without injury.

The fire, which was sparked by a computer printer, caused about \$400,000 in damage to the structure and destroyed roughly \$200,000 worth of furniture and other items inside it, said Maurice Luque, a public information officer for the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department.
